Xcel Withholds Renewable Energy Fund Grant From an IGCC Plant in MN

IGCC (Integrated gasification combined cycle) coal plants gasify coal to create electricity. The gasification process allows removal of most pollutants and likely allows isolation of the CO2 for eventual sequestration underground. But if we (Heather & Ken) understand this article, Xcel has correctly denied an MN IGCC plant's grant request of \$10 million from MN's Renewable Energy Fund.
